SAMSON WAS ____DRIVEN NOT ____ LED.

"Out of the **eater**, something **to eat**; out of the **strong**, something **sweet**." For three days they could not give the answer. <u>Judges 14:14 (NIV)</u>

Then Samson's wife threw herself on him, sobbing, "You hate me! You don't really love me. You've given my people a riddle, but you haven't told me the answer." She cried the whole seven days. Judges 14:16-17 (NIV)

Samson said to them, "If you had not plowed with my heifer, you would not have solved my riddle." Judges 14:18 (NIV)

TWO EMOTIONS THAT TAKE STRONG PEOPLE DOWN

1. SAMSON BURNED WITH _____.

...[Samson] went down to Ashkelon, struck down thirty of their men, stripped them of their belongings and gave their clothes to those who had explained the riddle. <u>Judges 14:19 (NIV)</u>

Burning with anger, he went up to his father's house. And Samson's wife was given to the friend who had attended him at his wedding. <u>Judges 14:19-20 (NIV)</u>

2. SAMSON WAS FILLED WITH _____.

Finding a fresh jawbone of a donkey, he grabbed it and struck down a thousand men. Judges 15:15 (NIV)

Then Samson said, "With a donkey's jawbone **I have made donkeys of them**. With a donkey's jawbone **I have killed a thousand men**." Judges 15:15–16 (NIV)

You may say to yourself, **"My power** and **the strength of my hands** have produced this wealth for me." But **remember the Lord your God**, for it is he who gives the ability to produce wealth. <u>Deuteronomy 8:17-18</u> (NIV)

Trust GOD from the bottom of your heart; don't try to figure out everything on your own.
