THREE TRUTHS ABOUT INVESTING YOUR LIFE

2. GOD EXPECTS ME TO USE MY TALENTS.

After a long time the Master of those servants returned and settled accounts with them. [Matthew 25:19](#)

The man who had received five talents went at once and put his money to work and gained five more. So also, the one with two talents gained two more. But the man who had received the one talent went off, dug a hole in the ground and **hid his master's money**. [Matthew 25:16-18](#)
