"Shouldn't you have had mercy on your fellow servant just as I had on you?" In anger his master **turned him over to the jailers to be tortured**... Matthew 18:33-34 (NIV)

Some people stay happy until the day they die... Others have no happiness at all; they live and die with bitter hearts. **Job 21:23–25 (GNT)** 

### 3. Because I need forgiveness \_\_\_\_\_.

This is how my heavenly Father will treat each of you unless you forgive your brother or sister **from your heart**. Matthew 18:35 (NIV)
