Phase 1: DREAM (Age 75) Genesis 12:1-3

God: "I will make you into a great nation..."

Phase 2: DECISION Genesis 12:4

So Abraham left as the Lord had told him to...

Phase 3: DELAY (Age 86) Genesis 16:1

But Sarah still had not borne any children...

Phase 4: DIFFICULTY (Age 99) Genesis 17-18

How can a son be born to a man my age?

• Phase 5: **DEAD END Genesis 18:12**

Sarah laughed silently... "A woman my age have a baby? And with a husband as old as mine?"

• Phase 6: **DELIVERANCE** Genesis 21:2

Sarah became pregnant and bore a son to Abraham in his old age, at the very time God had promised him.

What To Do When You Reach A Dead End

Abraham believed in God who gives life to the dead and who creates something out of nothing. Romans 4:17 (NCV)

When hope was dead within him, Abraham went on hoping in faith... **He relied on the word of God**... **Romans** 4:18 (PHILLIPS)

Though it seemed Abraham's hope could not be fulfilled... he did become the father of many nations, **exactly** as **God had promised**. Romans 4:18 (PHILLIPS)

Without weakening in his faith, **he faced the fact** that his body was as good as dead... and Sarah's womb was also dead. Yet he **didn't waver with unbelief**... Romans 4:19-20 (NIV)

Abraham never doubted. He believed God, for his faith and trust grew ever stronger, and **he praised God** for this blessing **even before it happened**. He was completely sure that God was well able to do anything he promised. Romans 4:20-21 (TLB)
