What Does It Take To See And Respond With Love?

1. Look

When Jesus saw her... Luke 13:12 (NIV)

2. Take

If you love only the people who love you, you will get no reward. Even the tax collectors do that. And **if you are nice only to** your friends, you are no better than other people. Even those who don't know God are nice to their friends. <u>Matthew 5:46-47</u> (NCV)

3. Reach

When Jesus saw her, he called her forward and said to her, "Woman, you are set free from your infirmity." Then he put his hands on her, and immediately she straightened up and praised God. <u>Luke 13:10-13 (NLT)</u>

4. Expect

But the leader in charge of the synagogue was indignant that Jesus had healed her on the Sabbath day. "There are six days of the week for working," he said to the crowd. "Come on those days to be healed, not on the Sabbath." Luke 13:14 (NLT)

But Jesus replied, "You hypocrites! Each of you works on the Sabbath day! **Don't you untie your ox or your donkey** from its stall on the Sabbath and lead it out for water? This dear woman, a **daughter of Abraham**, has been held in bondage by Satan for eighteen years. Isn't it right that she be released, even on the Sabbath?" Luke 13:15–16 (NLT)

5. Seize

And may the Master **bour on the love** so it fills your lives and splashes over on everyone around you.
