Commandment #5:

Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the Lord your God is giving you. <u>Exodus 20:12</u> (NIV)

Honor: Time to value, respect, or highly esteem; to treat as precious, weighty or valuable.

1. Honoring my parents,

How do I honor my parents?

A wise child accepts a parent's discipline; a mocker refuses to listen to correction. Proverbs 13:1 (NLT)

2. Honoring my parents,

What if my parents hurt me deeply?

- Pray
- Seek
- Forgive
- Release

Anyone who does not take care of his family and those in his house has turned away from the faith. He is worse than a person who has never put his trust in Christ. <u>1 Timothy 5:8 (NLV)</u>

3. Honoring my parents,

What is my responsibility to my parents?

- Love them
- Care for them
- Remember them
- Continue to Honor them

Listen to your father, who gave you life, and don't despise your mother when she is old. Proverbs 23:22 (NLT)

Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people. Colossians 3:23 (NLT)
