The Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: **love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control**. <u>Galatians 5:22–23</u> (NLT)

Kindness: "chrestotes": the active will to do good to others. Empathy in action.

Goodness: "agathosune": having moral excellence through active benevolence toward others.

Be kind to each other, **tenderhearted**, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you. **Ephesians 4:32** (NLT)

You should know this, Timothy, that in the last days there will be very difficult times. For people will love only themselves and their money. They will be boastful and proud, scoffing at God, disobedient to their parents, and **ungrateful**. They will consider nothing sacred. They will be **unloving** and **unforgiving**; they will slander others and have no self-control. They will be cruel and **hate what is good**. They will betray their friends, be reckless, be puffed up with pride, and love pleasure rather than God. They will act religious, but they will reject the power that could make them godly. Stay away from people like that! 2 Timothy 3:1-5 (NLT)
