He came to the sheep pens along the way; a cave was there, and Saul went in to relieve himself. David and his men were far back in the cave. The men said, "This is the day the Lord spoke of when he said to you, 'I will give your enemy into your hands for you to deal with as you wish.'" Then David crept up unnoticed and cut off a corner of Saul's robe. [1 Samuel 24:3-4 \(NIV\)](#)

1. Temptations are usually that cost more later.

"Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil..." **Psalm 23 (NIV)**

He said to his men, "The Lord forbid that I should do such a thing to my master, the Lord's anointed, or lay my hand on him; for he is the anointed of the Lord." [1 Samuel 24:6 \(NIV\)](#)

So David and Abishai went to the army by night, and there was Saul, lying asleep inside the camp with his spear stuck in the ground near his head. Abner and the soldiers were lying around him. Abishai said to David, "Today God has delivered your enemy into your hands. Now let me pin him to the ground with one thrust of the spear; I won't strike him twice." [1 Samuel 26:7-8 \(NIV\)](#)

2. Temptation feelings; obedience God's timing.

But David said to Abishai, "Don't destroy him! Who can lay a hand on the Lord's anointed and be guiltless? As surely as the Lord lives," he said, "the Lord himself will strike him, or his time will come and he will die, or he will go into battle and perish. But the Lord forbid that I should lay a hand on the Lord's anointed. Now get the spear and water jug that are near his head, and let's go." [1 Samuel 26: 9-11 \(NIV\)](#)

"Yes, my soul, find rest in God; my hope comes from him." [Psalm 62:5-8 \(NIV\)](#)

3. Temptation wants to God's and for your life.

After fasting forty days and forty nights, he was hungry. The tempter came to him and said, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread." Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that'
